





He founded TadEkam in 2007 to bring all the teachings and spiritual practices under one umbrella. He is in constant communication with Mahavatar Babaji, whom he met in 2010.

MBTF in Kotturu, Macherla Mandal

TadEkam foundation adopted Kotturu village in Macherla Mandal as part of the Smart Village program launched by Honourable CM of Andhra Pradesh, Sri Nara Chandrababu Naidu. As part of this program, we have done many developmental works in Kotturu.

Kotturu is at the border of Andhra and Telangana in the Guntur district. It is located between Nagarjuna Sagar dam and Macherla town. It has a population of 2000, with 510 households. Though the village has the Nagarjuna Sagar right branch canal, it doesn't have water facility as it is on higher elevation.

During one of our visits, we identified a defunct water body called Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Kunta. We deepened the water body and made it functional. About 40 borewells benefited from this, and the defunct and dried-up borewells also started functioning.

We also constructed borewell recharge pits. A small initiative of MBTF has become a lifeline to the village.

Street Lights:

As part of developmental activities in Kotturu, we have arranged street lights for the first time in Kotturu.





Improvement in Education Facilities:

Basic facilities for MANDAL PARISHAD UPPER PRIMARY (MPUP) school were provided by the Foundation. MBTF improved the infrastructure of the school and also constructed a compound wall. The organization also provided desks, benches and RO drinking water facilities.

Appointed teachers and their salaries were paid by the foundation on regular basis. Provision of computers and improvement of MPUP school in ST (Scheduled Tribes) colony was also done.

MBTF also planted saplings in the school to make the area green and welcoming.

Educating Parents to Stop Child Marriages:

Parents were hesitant to send their girl children to school. It was common practice to marry them off as minors.

To prevent this situation MBTF offered an incentive of Rs. 1000 per month in the bank account of girl students studying beyond 8th class.

MBTF provided cycles to students who come from nearby villages to this school. We also provided them with uniforms, shoes and books.













Other Developmental Activities:

- Medical camps and eye camps were conducted and MBTF distributed 300 spectacles to the needy.
- Tailoring training classes for the women as well as driving classes for youth were conducted by MBTF.
- Cement and gravel roads were constructed in the village by MBTF as internal roads. We spent almost 1 crore on Kotturu for this development.
- We constructed a culvert in the village for people's convenience.
- MBTF contributed Rs. 3000 per household, in addition to the government's grant of Rs. 12,000 and which facilitated the construction of toilets.
- We provided groceries to numbers of old people who are unable to get their pensions.
- At one time, this village was known as a faction village because of the unrest among its inhabitants. Now, with MBTF's contributions, the crime rate has reduced dramatically and the people are more hopeful about their future.













MBTF in Development of Schools in MACHERLA MANDAL







After successful developmental projects in Kotturu, we planned developmental works in the educational sector. For this purpose, we started smart schools in 32 villages of Macherla Mandal.

We donated benches, provided RO water facilities and constructed bathrooms in various schools of Macherla Mandal under the Guntur district.



MBTF in Dedicated Rural Services **BURUGUPUD**I



Burugupudi and Kirlampudi Mandal, East Godavari

Burugupudi is a typical village in East Godawari District of Andhra pradesh.. The Sarpanch of the village Sri Patamsetti Surya Chandra sought MBTF to take up his village for various developmental activities. Under this mission, the village was witnessed developmental work amounting to Rs. 30 lakhs, between 2016-2019.

MBTF constructed a community building worth Rs. 6 lakhs, to be used for projects related to women's empowerment. We also identified a shortage of teachers in the zilla parishad high school of the village. We sponsored the salaries of 5 teachers for 2 years, amounting to Rs. 9,60,000.

Additionally, MBTF supplied desks for the students worth Rs. 3 lakhs, opened a school library with books for all competitive exams worth 76,000, supplied 41 ceiling fans worth Rs. 56,000, and provided sports uniforms and sports equipment worth Rs. 1 lakh.

MBTF also identified 9 merit students and supported them with Rs. 90,000 to complete their Intermediate Education.

With TadEkam's encouragement, most of the students secured a 9.2 score in the Tenth class and two students who got 10/10, were selected for IIIT.

Due to the devotion and efforts of Sri Patamsetti Surya Chandra, MBTF also took up an important renovation project. The temple of Sankalpa Sidheswara Kotilingeswara Swami was renovated. Presently the organization has built separate quarters for the Archakas with Rs. 5,50,000 and is paying Rs. 15,000 per month as salary to the priests.

In order to help unemployed youth, MBTF set up a facility to learn car driving, spending a total of Rs. 1,50,000.

Rural health being its priority, the organization also conducted an eye camp for the rural needy with the help of Kiran Eye Hospital and provided free spectacles to them.

As a part of environmental protection and conservation, MBTF also started a wide range of tree plantations and freely distributed cloth bags to prevent the usage of plastic bags.



MBTF in Jaggampeta Constituency - Janasena Party



Jaggampeta East in Godavari District

With a mission to volunteer for the poor and needy in their tough times, MBTF always stands first with its excellent services. To expand voluntary services, MBTF has collarborated with Sri Nadendla Manohar, Sri Pantham Nanaji, and Sri Kandula Durgesh.

MBTF distributed nearly 80 tricycles to the physically handicapped under the guidance of Janasena Party.

In order to promotes spiritual growth, MBTF helped to construct Sri Varaha Lakshmi Narasimha Swami temple at Thirumalaya Palem with Rs. 15 lakhs under the guidance of Janasena.

MBTF constructed nearly 10 small houses for the needy. As per part of this operation, MBTF also laid gravel roads to the farms in Mallisala village in Jaggampeta Mandal.

During the pandemic, MBTF started two Covid camps — one in Jaggampeta Mandal and another in Gokavaram Mandal. MBTF also provided oxygen cylinders, oxygen concentrators and a doctor on call service.

MBTF also distributed healthy foods to pregnant ladies.

The Janasena workers actively joined hands with MBTF to supply medical kits worth Rs. 2,23,000.

MBTF conducted scholarship test for all government school students in Kirlampudi Mandal and gave scholarships worth Rs. 1.50 lakhs.



MBTF in Rajamundry and Kakinada with **Janasena Party**



MBTF started developmental activities in Rajahmundry and Kakinada rural comprising 18 villages.

We started with Pidimigoyyi High School and distributed school benches, cupboards, sports equipment, computers and made the school more lively and self-sufficient.

We distributed tricycles to the handicapped and sewing machines to women as part of the women empowerment in satellite city.

TadEkam foundation contributed Rs. 70,000 to the homeless to help construct a home. The remaining amount was pooled by the Janasena party.

When we started our journey in Kakinada, we noticed the electric poles were empty with no street lights. We acted on this situation and restored street lights with in the village.

OUR ACHIEVEMENTS AND

MBTF was chosen as one of the 25 MOST **ACTIVE PARTNERS** in **2017**, out of 10,000 partners in Andhra Pradesh by the State Government.

The Government has sanctioned a grid for drinking water, which will be lifted from Krishna basin at Nagarjuna Sagar Dam and storage points are fixed at different villages.

50% of the cost will be borne by the MBTF.





Team MBTF met with the Guntur MP to highlight the acute shortage of water in Kotturu as borewells are not feasible given the lack of ground water. Water tankers were arranged for the village till a permanent solution was implemented (Rain water harvesting and Supply of water through irrigation pumps).

MBTF was asked to present the activities undertaken so far and its future plans and suggestions to the State Government on 13th October 2015.

GOVERNMENT APPROVALS:

The AP government was impressed with the dedication and efforts of MBTF. Our presentation was selected to be shown to the CM.

On 11th January 2016, 3 out of 15 smart village partners were selected and honored for their performance by the government.
